The State Government for some time past has been considering the need for extending benefits to larger section of meritorious students from poor economic background. The State Government, in order to extend the benefits of the Swami Vivekananda Merit-cum-Means Scholarship Scheme (hereafter referred to as the 'Scheme') to the larger section of meritorious students from poor economic background, to make the Scheme more inclusive, has been considering on reassessing the qualifying marks for the applicants.

In partial modification of this Department notification No:401A-Edn(CS)/10M-15/07 dated: 25-04-2007, the Governor has been pleased to extend the benefit of the Swami Vivekananda Merit-cum-Means Scholarship Scheme to include larger section of meritorious students from poor economic background within its scope. The Governor has been pleased to reassess the qualifying marks for the applicants of the Scheme and has been pleased to decrease the qualifying marks of Swami Vivekananda Merit cum Means Scholarship for the financial year 2021-22 for the students who have scored 60% and above in aggregate in Madhyamik Pariksha for Higher Secondary Level, 60% and above in aggregate in Higher Secondary Examination for UG Level and whose family income is not more than Rs.2,50,000/- per annum.


